Preparations continue for the 2025 Lake Placid Horse Shows (LPHS), which will feature two weeks of world-class FEI CSI 3* competition at the newly renovated North Elba Showgrounds, June 24-July 6.

The remarkable upgrades include reconstructed show rings with state-of-the-art all-weather international competition footing. Improvements are being made to the stabling and schooling areas. Highlights include a resurfaced all-weather grand prix ring, an expanded jumper ring, two new hunter rings and a dedicated FEI exercise ring.

We are also proud to announce that this year, we received FEI (Federation Equestre Internationale) status, enabling us to offer a prestigious CSI3* event! This significant upgrade elevates our competition to a new level, attracting top-tier equestrians from around the globe and offering them an unparalleled show experience.

The Highlight from The 2024 Lake Placid Horse Show Grand Prix was watching Brian Moggre and MTM Vivre Le Reve celebrate their first Grand Prix win on our top-of-the-line all-weather international footing ring! Similarly, at the I Love NY Horse Show, Laura Chapot and Chandon Blue achieved a memorable victory in our final competition on the scenic grass field during the Richard M. Feldman Grand Prix. These moments exemplify the joy and excitement that our shows bring to the equestrian sport and community. The Lake Placid Horse Show, a USEF Heritage competition, offers a unique blend of high-level equestrian sport and family-friendly entertainment, contributing significantly to our region's economy and community spirit. It is estimated that our horse shows bring in approximately \$18 million to our local community.
